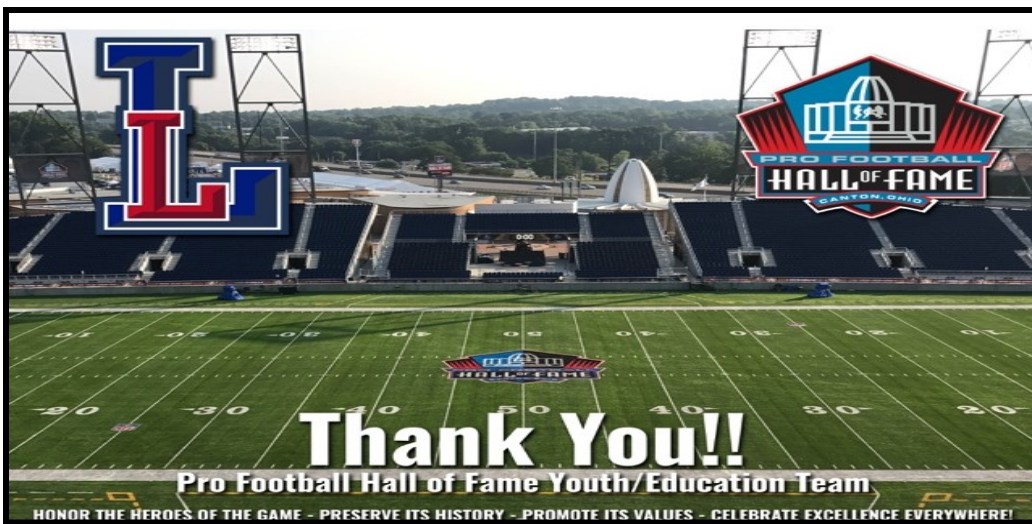

In preparation for the Memorial Day holiday, Lancer Football team members took a moment to honor our local veterans.

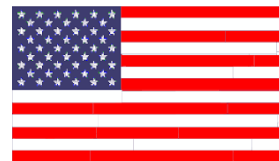
Team members placed flags at three local cemeteries in the Hebron community for those who have served their country.

There will be 5 different weight classes and players in grades 9-12 next year will participate unless they are in a baseball, track event or injured.

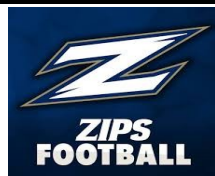
