MARCH TESTING SHOWS LANCERS GROWTH



The football Lancers hard work showed signs of paying off recently as players

were tested for the first time since December.

Bench press numbers increased an average of 14.6 lbs. as 80% of those tested twice improved their max!

Squat max numbers also

improved as 71% of those players who tested twice improved an average of 29 lbs.

Dead Lifts also imers who tested twice improved an average of 40.8 lbs.

Cleans as 67% of players who tested twice 45 lbs. per lift! improved their max!

Largest growth cam from RB/DB Isaiah Mitchell! The Freshmen Improved his Bench Press from 155 lbs. to 200 lbs. His proved as 81% of play- Deadlift from 315 lbs. to 370 lbs.

He also made a big jump on Squats from 255 lbs. An increase of 14.5 to 315 lbs. and Hang Ibs. was made in Hang Cleans from 135 lbs. to 155 lbs.! An average of


