LAKEWOOD WINS 28TH ANNUAL DANVILLE MEET





The Lakewood powerlifting team made up of 100% members of the football team won the 28th Annual Danville Powerlifting Meet. Because of COVID, the meet was moved from February to June and was held outside.

The Lancers totaled **11,280 lbs.**, just finishing ahead of Clear Fork by 20 lbs. who totaled **11,260** lbs. Danville was third with **10,400** lbs. This was the first time since 2012 that Lakewood has won a Powerlifting meet.

1st Place finishes went to **Trenten Markus** (8th-145lb Class), **Josiah Ellinger** (11th-195lbs.Class), **Jake Cassady** (12th-225lbs Class), **Keegan Jacks** (9th-Unlimited Class) & **Eli Dornbirer** (11th-Unlimited Class).

2nd Place finishes went to **Logan Bush** (8th Grade – 155lb Class), **Brayden Shull** (8th-175lb. Class), **Lane Allen** (8th – 195lb Class), **Isaiah Mitchell** (9th-155lb Class), **Josh Hicks** (10th-175lb Class), **Mark Waters** (11th–185lb. Class), **Jake Ellinger**,(10th–195lb. Class), **Cole Moran** (9th-205lb Class), & **Kaleb Fellure** (11th–250lb. Class).

67 personal bests were set at the meet by the 24 athletes that competed! **Josh Hicks** had Best Squat & Deadlift in his class, **Xander Angle** had best bench in his class, **Jake Cassady** had best Bench and Squat & **Keegan Jacks** had best Bench.


