LANCER ELITE ACHIEVEMENT CUP COMPETITION

Starting this academic year the Lancers football program will begin a new tradition

built around the importance of academics.

The ELITE Achievement Cup is a yearly competition between the football grade levels to promote the commitment to academics, community and the process of building a winning football program. The competition is made up of five categories that include:

GPA Average School Attendance School Discipline Community Service Lancer Commitment

At the end of each grading period each category will be calculated by grade level and ranked accordingly. First place will receive 5 points, Second place will earn 3 points and third place will collect 1 point.

Grade levels will then be ranked each grading period. At the end of the school year, the grade level with the highest points will have their graduation year engraved on the cup and other incentives.

The cup will be displayed in the football locker room as a reminder of our commitment to the ELITE qualities of becoming a successful student athlete both on and off the field. Standings to be posted soon!

Lakewood was represented this year at the district level with five players making the list.

Senior WR Tristan Warthman was named to first

team. Warthman had 41 receptions for 637 yards & 2 touchdowns. He also rushed for 242 yards, threw for one touchdown and had 33 tackles defensively.

David Moody was a 2nd team selection and led the lancers in total tackles with 68 while also rushing

for 168 yards & hauling in 11 receptions for 130 yards.

Quarterback, Connor Vierstra, Junior Wide Receiver, Zaven Boland & Junior Offensive Lineman Dane Black were selected as Honorable Mention All-Central selections.

LANCERS ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS ANNOUNCED

Senior WR **Tristan Warthman** was named to first team. Warthman had 41 receptions for 637 yards and 2 touchdowns. He also rushed for 242 yards and threw for one touchdown. He also had 33 tackles defensively.

Quarterback, **Connor Vierstra** was selected to the second team. The Sophomore

threw for nearly 1,700 yards while completing 132 of 222 passes 11 touchdowns and 12 interceptions.

Senior David Moody, Juniors Zaven Boland & Dane Black were Honorable Mention selections.

David Moody led the lancers in total tackles with 68 while also rushing for 168 yards and hauling in 11 receptions for 130 yards.

Junior **Zaven Boland** was second on the team with 38 receptions for 490

yards and a team leading 6 touchdowns.

Junior Dane Black was a 10 game starter on the offensive line and recorded 28 tackles defensively from his defensive line position. Additionally, he was selected nine times as a team captain and was a constant on the Gold accountability chart.

Warthman will be honored at the LCL Banquet on **Sunday November 19th** for his first team selection.

Football accountability groups are designed to monitor our athletes in-

vestment, trust and positive impact of our program. Entitlement based on grade level status <u>is</u> not part of our process.

During the season players are evaluated bi-

monthly by the coaching staff and put into different color groups.

Gold is the highest level you can obtain, followed by Blue+, Blue, Blue-, White+, White, White- and the lowest level which is red.

Players are allotted certain privileges, including how they are put in order for certain football rituals.

Lancer Football Touchdown Club


