Vierstra who threw for over 1,700 yards and completed nearly 60% of his passes earned 1st team All-LCL, 1st team All-District & 1st team All-Region 11. Running back Connor Roesink who averaged 4.6 yards a carry and hauled in 36 receptions earned 1st team All-LCL, 1st Team Region 11, & Special Mention All-District.

Junior **Colt Vierstra** who led the Lancers in receptions with 41, received 2nd Team All-LCL, 1st Team All-Region 11 and Special Mention All-District. Senior **Noah Sniadach** who had 411 reception yards, received 2nd team All-LCL, 1st team All-Region 11 and Special Mention All-District.
